
## HISTORICAL EVENTS IN THE BIBLE PROMISE OF CHILD TO ABRAHAM AND SARAH


him, and will make him




up his eyes and looked, and lo, three men stood saw, he ran to meet them from his tent door, and

by him; and when he bowed himself toward the ground, and said,







shall pass on; for therefore are ye come to your servant. And they said,
